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Executive Summary

Fontanel Lake Retreat offers a scalable, high-impact hospitality model with strong returns and social value.

Fontanel Lake Retreat is a purpose-driven experiential lodging destination nestled on 50 acres in Burgaw, NC, featuring a serene 25-acre private lake. The property comes with one fully operational Airbnb Lake home already generating \$9,000/month during peak season. We have a vision to expand the income potential by adding three A-frame cabins, two houseboats, and creating a boutique retreat for wellness, nature immersion, and curated experiences.

Guests will enjoy kayaking, mini-farm animals, farm-to-table dining, and serenity, all while supporting our broader mission to uplift single women and their families facing housing insecurity.

Investment Opportunity	We are seeking \$500,000 to fund construction, branding, and launch operations. With projected monthly revenue exceeding \$33,000.
The Leadership	Sherry and Stephen Danalis bring over 14 years of dedicated experience supporting vulnerable women, complemented by a diverse entrepreneurial background, including their most recent success launching and scaling a thriving microgreens business in New England.
The Overall Industry	The short-term rental industry, especially among Airbnb hosts, is undergoing a major transformation in 2025. Guests no longer want just a place to sleep; they want a story to tell. Airbnb's relaunch of its Experience and New Service segment has seen strong early adoption with over 60,000 host applications.
Others In The Space	Unique properties drive demand. Treehouses, A-frame cabins, floating homes, and glamping setups are outperforming traditional listings. Guests want memorable, nature-connected stays that feel personal and immersive.
The Financial Status	We have an initial capital of \$975,000 from donations and loans to purchase the property and the necessary capital assets to manage the business. We will be self-sustaining and no longer require donor funding by year 4
Future Plans	We are actively expanding our service offerings to include the construction of three homes for vulnerable families, microgreens cultivation, and event hosting, each designed to deepen our impact and create sustainable revenue streams. Future collaborations with mission-aligned organizations will further enhance our capacity to serve vulnerable women with greater reach and effectiveness.

The joy of watching women experience personal transformation leaves them excited to leverage their experience on a new scale.

His entrepreneurial journey includes launching a successful microgreens business in New England and operating an independent car sales venture—each rooted in his commitment to sustainability, dignity, and service.

THE HISTORY

F.U.S.E has served over 30+ women and welcomed 9 babies into Nehemiah House. We transitioned to the Greater Wilmington Area in the summer of 2024, accepting an invitation to partner in a proposed development of a 22-tiny home community in Holly Ridge, NC, for women in recovery.



FUSE's first home, The Nehemiah House has been providing young mom's with a safe environment to welcome their babies into as well as create a critical foundation that babies need for healthy development. When mom is free from violence and exploitation and surrounded by love and support, everyone thrives.

Our second home (pilot), Wellspring Freedom Home was operational through 2020, during COVID, and the data we collected showed these women had little to no support when they were single mothers, resources were limited, their children were taken from them, and the cycle of exploitation and violence began.

In the beginning of **2021,**

Collected data over several years revealed that safe housing options were limited. Once Nehemiah House guests were ready to reside independently, they lacked safe housing and were faced with challenges. It became clear that sustainable safe housing options and job opportunities would continue to prevent further exploitation and increased independent living.

Immersive Stays. Curated Experience.

Travelers are seeking immersive, nature-based experiences most Airbnb listings are generic and lack curated activities.



A Rare Private Lake Opportunity near Wilmington and Coastal Attractions.

Fontanel Lake Retreat will redefine experiential travel in North Carolina by offering a secluded, nature-immersive getaway on a 50-acre property with a 25-acre private lake near Wilmington, NC. With a proven income stream from an existing lakefront home, the expansion into A-frame cabins and houseboats will triple revenue and create a boutique destination for wellness, adventure, and serenity. In addition to the main property, the offering includes three adjacent lots totaling 10 acres off Cape Fear Drive.

Currently operating as a successful wedding venue generating up to \$9,000 per month during peak season, the property combines natural beauty with income-producing potential. With approval for up to eight primary residences and four accessory dwelling units (ADUs), the site is well-positioned for development or expansion into a boutique resort, family compound, or short-term rental retreat.

Actively listed at \$1.4 million, Fontanel Lake invites visionaries looking to capitalize on North Carolina's rising demand for experiential real estate and lakeside escapes.

- Residents live in an inclusive environment where they have the opportunity to strengthen interpersonal skills and prepare to develop healthy relationships upon their eventual transition into independence.

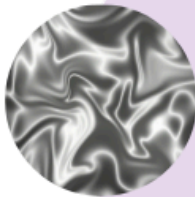

More about the Founders

Sherry and Stephen Danalis have been married for 31+ years and have 2 grown sons, Cameron and Alexander. In 2008, they suffered the tragic loss of their adopted daughter from Korea. What followed awakened the passion to learn more about the plight of young women who experience loss and exploitation when they don't have the support, resources, and community they desperately need for better outcomes. What started as a platform of awareness has now grown to provide safe housing options. The first home, Nehemiah House, for seven years, offered a family-style residential home with pathways to financial stability and independence and closed in December 2023 to transition to independent housing, called Renewal Home. F.U.S.E. was established in 2010 (received charitable status in the summer of 2011).

Stephen graduated from Rhode Island School of Design in 1984 with a Bachelor in Culinary Arts. A Restaurateur and entrepreneur for several years, serving on several mission trips through the AG World Missions (MAPS) ranging from pouring concrete floors and walls in Honduras to accompanying a medical outreach in Kenya until "THE CALL" to the Mission Field himself in the States. Stephen's heart cry is to see faith communities emerge with one voice, not only to raise awareness but more importantly INSPIRE others into action on behalf of the vulnerable to see the community come together.
